

Child Protection Team Meetings

Title 33 VSA Sections 4917-4919

Child Protection Teams (CPTs) are local, multi-disciplinary teams that serve families whose children are at risk of abuse and neglect. Team members are professionals and representatives from community agencies officially empanelled to serve by the Commissioner of the Department of Children and Families pursuant to the Vermont law noted above. Additionally persons are temporarily empanelled when their services are appropriate to the discussion with or about any particular family.

Lamoille North Supervisory Union (LNSU) Schools will implement the legal requirements to call for or participate in a child protection team meeting. The principal of the school may request a child protection team meeting by:

1. Contacting the Director of the Lamoille Department of Children and Families: Family Services Division, or by
2. Contacting the LNSU Director of Student Support Services

Child Protection Team meetings will be held if a child is considered to be unsafe or if DCF contacts us as required by Act 62 for assistance in a case that has been found through their assessment process to be at high risk.

All CPT meetings that include LNSU school personnel will be documented using the LNSU CPT Member Sign in Sheet and the LNSU Fax Form. These confidential documents will be faxed to the LNSU Director of Student Support Services immediately following the meeting. All follow up meetings will follow these same procedures.
